

HERE'S HOW TO PUT ON A HOODIE DRIVE

- 1. Identify and gather your Hoodie team friends, colleagues, etc.
- 2. Determine your campaign timeframe. Drives should be completed by November 7.

- 4. Try using a little collegial rivalry. Who will have school bragging rights in your group?
- 5. Set up a convenient collection location. It could be your workspace or a common area.
- 6. Drop off your hoodies at United Way's offices at 1250 Penn Avenue in The Strip by November 14.
- 7. Share your drive photos and success on social. Be sure to tag photos *@unitedwayswpa* and use hashtag *#HoodiesForTheHolidays*
