- Begin giving at the \$10,000 level again
- Use the 5-year Tocqueville Society step-up plan:
 - Year one: \$5,000
 - Year two: \$6,000
 - Year three: \$7,000
 - Year four: \$9,000
 - Year five: \$10,000
