We operate in the counties of Allegheny, Armstrong, Butler, Fayette and Westmoreland, bringing together local agencies and volunteers to serve the needs of local populations. But we've found the most effective way to impact local communities is through the guidance at the local (often hyper-local) level. PA 211: Our community's lifeline to essential services.

When an individual or family finds themselves in crisis and doesn't know where to turn, United Way is there. United Way's PA 211 emergency helpline connects our most vulnerable neighbors with essential services at any time, 365 days a year, through phone, text or online. Last year alone, our highly trained 211 Resource Navigators assisted more than 262,000 people with issues from avoiding possible eviction to connecting low-wage workers with free tax preparation.

In 2021, United Way of Southwestern Pennsylvania:

- Assisted more than 1,000 individuals struggling with housing, utilities, and transportation needs.
- Delivered more than 15,000 books and resources to early learning classrooms impacting over 4,000 kids.
- Provided free tax preparation to over 7,000 low-income workers, giving them access to much-needed money they've earned.
