Tell me about your role at United Way.

I'm part of the Community Impact team where I have the privilege of supporting our partners in the Moving to Financial Stability portfolio. I also dedicate much of my time to two of our Community Change Collaboratives: the Free Tax Prep Coalition and the Alliance for Access and Assets.

What are two things you enjoy most about working here?

What's a fun fact about you that most people don't know?

I've participated in storytelling competitions.
